2015 MOTODOFFO "GRAN TINTO"

The 2015 Gran Tinto is a striking blend that will not disappoint. Composed of 85% 2015 Zinfandel and 15% 2014 Petite Sirah, this blend shows deep ruby red color with hints of garnet. Aromas of ripe black plum, figs, blackberries, blueberries and cherries give way to spices like clove, vanilla, maple syrup and mint. The Gran Tinto is a big and potent wine with plenty of volume, but its balanced acidity helps to coat the palate and leave a pleasant finish.

an additional 36-48 months

PAIR IT WITH: Chicken with Mole Sauce

BARREL PROGRAM:
